

Privacy Policy

Effective Date: July 1, 2022

This Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy”) describes the types of information BioProcure, Inc. (BioProcure, our, we) collects on the <https://www.bioprocure.com> website (“Site” or “Website”), how we use such information and to whom and under what circumstances we may disclose it. Please be sure to read this entire Privacy Policy before using or submitting information to this Site or through a mobile device. **By accessing the Site (by computer, mobile device, tablet or any other method) you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, please do not use this Site.**

Consent

By using this Site, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. Whenever you submit information to this Site, through a mobile device, or otherwise, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of that information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, please do not use this Site and please do not submit any Personal Information to us through a mobile device or otherwise.

Personal identification information

Depending on how you use the Site, we may ask you to share Personal Information with us. “Personal Information” means any information about an identifiable individual, such as your name, email address, mailing address, gender, date of birth, any data about you that you elect to provide electronically through the Site and any other information that identifies who you are. You will be informed about what information is required and what information is optional at the point of collection. Whether you choose to share your Personal Information is completely up to you. Please do not submit any Personal Information if you do not want it to be collected.

Passive information

As you review the Site, certain anonymous information may be passively collected using various technologies such as “cookies”, web beacons, Internet tags, and navigational data collection. Your browser automatically transmits to the Site some of this anonymous information. Our Site may use and combine such passively collected information to provide better service to Site visitors, compile and analyze trends and statistics, and otherwise improve the Website for your use. Such information is not combined with Personal Information collected elsewhere on the Site unless we have your permission.

A “cookie” is a small text file that is placed on your computer when you access the Site and allows us to recognize you each time you visit the Site. We may use cookies to: (a) enhance or personalize your Site usage; (b) monitor Site usage; (c) manage the Site; and (d) improve the Site and our products and services. If you choose, you can set your browser to reject cookies or you can manually delete individual cookies or all of the cookies on your computer by following your browser’s help file directions. If you decide to turn off or block cookies, our Site might not function correctly. An “Internet tag” is smaller than a cookie and tells the website server information such as IP address and browser type related to the visitor’s computer.

How we use collected information

In general, we may use the information we collect from and about you for any of the following purposes: (1) to communicate and respond to your inquiries; (2) to fulfill your requests for information; (3) to manage the security of our Site, physical locations, networks, and systems, (4) to review Site usage and operations, (5) to address problems with the Site, or business or our services, (6) to tailor our marketing activities to your interests and in accordance with your communication preferences, (7) to contact you by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation, (8) to comply with legal requirements or to establish or exercise our legal rights to defend against legal claims, (9) to respond to law enforcement requests or where required by applicable laws, court orders, or government regulations, or (10) when we believe it is necessary to share information in an investigation regarding, or to prevent, illegal activities suspected fraud, or potential threats to the safety of any person.

We do not sell, trade, or rent the personal identification information that we collect via this Site. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any Personal Information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates and advertisers that agree to treat it in accordance with this Privacy Policy and use it for the same purposes.

How we protect your information

We maintain reasonable and appropriate security measures to maintain information we collect in a secure manner. We have taken certain steps to safeguard the information we collect from users of the Site. Even though we follow a reasonable procedure to try to protect the information in our possession, no security system is perfect, and we cannot promise, and you should not expect, that your information will be secure in all circumstances.
